Apparatus Equipped with a Fire Pump

Apparatus Equipped with a Fire Pump (Pump Ops) program meets the knowledge and skill requisites established by the NFPA 1002 Standard for Fire Apparatus Driver – Operator Professional Qualifications Chapter 5, 2014 Edition.

This course will cover the job performance requirements that shall be met under NFPA 1002 Chapter 5, 2014 Edition. Upon successful completion of this course each student will understand and be able to demonstrate the operation of a fire department pumper from both a static and pressurized source of water.

Provincial testing through Academic Standards and Evaluation with the Office of the Fire Marshal and Emergency Management will be available at the conclusion of the course for students wishing to receive certification.

Prerequisites: NFPA 1001 Fire Fighter I or NFPA 1001 Fire Fighter I Recruit, and a **valid** DZ License.

Proof of a valid DZ License must be presented to the Instructor at the commencement of the class. Students that fail to provide the proper documentation will not be eligible to attend the class.

Day 1:

Morning Session – 0800hrs

In Class Theory:

- New car technology
- New metals within today's vehicles and how to deal with them Day 1

Afternoon Session – HOT:

- Cribbing techniques
- Glass management using new era tools
- Using bread and butter techniques on 4 door cars on their wheels • Techniques implemented when there is minimal manpower

Day 2:

- Dealing with patient care while extricating from vehicles on their sides while using struts
- Vehicles on their roof and proper techniques when minivans are present
- The remainder of the day will be used for practical scenarios and live rescues using all the lessons learned in the previous 2 days. Prerequisite: Basic auto extrication skills preferred. Students are responsible to bring required PPE for performing auto extrication, including safety glasses. Coveralls may be worn (long sleeved) Failure to have the proper PPE may result in the student being ineligible to attend.
